SUBJECT: FRINGE BENEFITS FOR CITY EMPLOYEES

1. PURPOSE.

The purpose of this memorandum is to establish in writing an informal policy of furnishing the same fringe benefits to all employees of City government, regardless of the source of funding.

2. POLICY

With the advent of Federal funding for many programs of City government, funds have become available from Federal Sources to provide benefits for City employees such as mileage for travel, tuition payments for education, vehicles, and basic pay.

The existing policy memorandums relative to fringe benefits, pay, use of vehicles, and mileage shall apply and no greater benefits shall be permitted for federally funded employees than those fringe benefits that are allowed for employees funded from the General Fund.
