CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC NECESSITY AND CONVENIENCE (CPNC)

CPNC Vehicle Markings

Please follow this guideline for marking your vehicle:

Do not put the word CPNC on the vehicle. Only the two (2) letters identifying the type of CPNC, the dash and the number are allowed on the vehicle (ex. LM-01, NE-01, SS-01 or GC-01).

All vehicle markings must contrast prominently against the vehicle color.

Where LPSC numbers are required, numbers must include the specific identifying markers. I.e.: XXXX.1, XXXX.2, etc.

Limousines

- CPNC number is required to be 3” (located on the rear quarter panel behind tires on both sides of vehicle).
- Vehicle unit numbers are not allowed. A written request may be made, by company owners, to the Bureau for the CPNC number to be placed in additional locations for vehicle identification purposes.

Buses

- CPNC number is required to be 5” (located on the rear quarter panel behind tires on both sides of vehicle and the rear of bus at the centered or top left)
- Company name must be a minimum of 6” on both sides of bus
- Vehicle unit numbers are not allowed. A written request may be made, by company owners, to the Bureau for the CPNC number to be placed in additional locations for vehicle identification purposes.

Vans & SUV’s

- CPNC number is required to be 4” (located on the rear quarter panel behind tires on both side of vehicle).
- Company name must be a minimum of 6” on both sides of Van (optional for Limousine Companies).

- Company name not required on SUV's (Limousine companies only)
- Vehicle unit numbers are not allowed. A written request may be made, by company owners, to the Bureau for the CPNC number to be placed in additional locations for vehicle identification purposes.

Sedans

- CPNC number is required to be 3" (located on the rear quarter panel behind tires on both sides of vehicle).
- Vehicle unit numbers are not allowed. A written request may be made, by company owners, to the Bureau for the CPNC number to be placed in additional locations for vehicle identification purposes.

Taxicabs

- CPNC number is required to be 5" (located on the front left hood, rear right trunk lid, and each front fender).
- Company name and logo located on each front door and trunk lid.
- Rate sign and company phone number located on each rear door.
- Yellow security camera notice to be placed on lower glass of rear door windows; right above the door handles. If the vehicle's windows are tinted, an additional yellow security camera notice is required to be placed on the inside of the rear windows, right above the door handles.
- Debit/Credit card stickers are to be placed on exterior glass of rear doors. Rear door vent windows are acceptable. If the vehicle is a van or an SUV, the debit/credit card sticker may be placed on the immovable 3rd row window.

Note: No signage is allowed on vehicle windows, with the exception of pre-approved taxi markings (ie: clear background rate signage, credit card signage, security camera signage).

Company names and phone numbers are not allowed vehicle windows.

Wheelchair accessible signage is allowed on areas pre-approved by the Bureau.
