
























Hearings during the period

Monthly totals










FEMA & SDER demolition output dwindles, Isaac creates new IDC cases

Cumulative Demolitions since Oct 1, 2010

















Status of housing units under contract






Owner-Occupied Rehabilitation

- 12 Owner-occupied units added to pipeline




Blue Plate Lofts Complete (72 units)
