The Central Business District Historic District Landmarks Commission's regularly scheduled meeting will take place on **Wednesday, March 18, 2015, in the City Council Chamber, 1300 Perdido Street at 10:00 AM**. At this meeting public hearings may be heard on the following applications:

The following items will be placed on the consent agenda:

602-610 S Peters St: Construct 4000 sf penthouse, and construction of uncovered gallery on Fulton Street elevation.

1037 Magazine St, 1119 Poeyfarre St: Enclosure of existing outdoor deck with glazed curtain wall system with sliding glass panels.

The following items will be placed on the regular agenda:

749-751 St Charles Ave: Partial demolition of existing building and construction of seven-story side and rear addition and renovation of remaining three-story building, including addition of balcony and new storefront.

820 Poydras St: Replace three (3) existing cellular antennas and install six (6) new cellular antennas at a Designated Landmark.

700 Tchoupitoulas St: Changing a window opening at the rear (Commerce St. side) of the building into a roll-up door.

103-111 Tchoupitoulas St, 400-422 Canal St: Demolition of 103-111 Tchoupitoulas Street including salvage and reuse of street facing walls and a small portion of side wall at 105 Tchoupitoulas Street; demolition of 400-422 Canal Street and appeal of ARC recommendation for denial of proposed 250 ft high hotel/parking garage.
