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
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About the Greater New Orleans Primary Care Safety Net

In the eight years since Hurricane Katrina, the primary care safety net in our region has grown significantly and rapidly. The Greater New Orleans Region primary care safety net now boasts 25 organizations operating 69 sites in Orleans, Jefferson, St. Bernard and Plaquemines Parishes, primarily serving uninsured, under-insured, and low-income residents regardless of insurance status or ability to pay. This neighborhood based network has made it easier for community members to seek high quality primary care.

These sites vary in ownership, scope and size, yet all share a commitment to serve everyone. They include mobile units, school-based health clinics, residency training sites, and those who serve special populations such as HIV-positive and homeless individuals. In 2012, this safety net served over 250,000 patients in our community. The network of community-based health centers and clinics that make up the safety net in this region has been lauded as a successful model for the nation by U.S. Department of Health and Human Services (HHS) Secretary Kathleen Sebelius.

What if I don't have insurance?

Medicaid

In Louisiana, you qualify to receive Medicaid if you:

- Receive Supplemental Security Income (SSI) from the Social Security Administration (SSA)
- Get financial help from the Office of Family Support (OFS) through the Family Independence Temporary Assistance Program (FITAP).

You may also qualify for Medicaid coverage if you:

- Are disabled according to the Social Security Administration's definition
- Have corrected vision no better than 20/200
- Are a low-income parent of children under age 19 making less than \$3,532/year (for a family of four)
- Are a child under age 19
- Are pregnant
- Have no insurance and need treatment for breast and/or cervical cancer
- Receive Medicare coverage and are low-income

How do I apply for Medicaid?

There are several ways you can apply for Medicaid or get more information:

- Apply or renew coverage for any Medicaid program by visiting the Louisiana Medicaid Online
 Application Center. Once you submit the online application, it is sent immediately to the Medicaid office
 for processing, and there is no delay for mailing or faxing a paper form.

The Greater New Orleans Community Health Connection (GNOCHC) is a special Medicaid program that provides basic health care for people who can't afford the high cost of health insurance. For those who qualify, GNOCHC provides access to primary and preventative care, labs, x-rays, mental health and substance use services, immunizations, and vaccines, all at no out-of-pocket cost.

Services are provided through the award-winning network of community health care centers in the region. To qualify, you must:

- Live in Orleans, Jefferson, St. Bernard, or Plaquemines Parish
- Be ages 19-64
- Be U.S. citizens or permanent resident
- Make less than: \$958/month as a family of 1; \$1,628/month as a family of 3; \$2,298/month as a family of 5
- Be uninsured

NOTE: You must meet ALL criteria in order to be eligible

To apply, you may be asked to provide:

- Proof of income (Copy of most recent W2, Filed tax forms, Most recent pay stubs, Unemployment award letter, Social Security/Disability award letter, Food stamp award letter)
- Government issued photo ID if current address is not on ID, a utility bill must be provided.
- Birth certificate or US permanent residency card

What if a patient does not qualify?

If a patient does not qualify, they will be charged a health center's sliding scale fee rate.

The Health Insurance Marketplace

The Marketplace is a tool to help you find insurance that is right for you at an affordable price. It will help uninsured and under-insured individuals and families find all the information they need about available health plans in one place. Most people who use the Marketplace will also qualify for tax credits, which work like discounts to lower the cost of the health plan they purchase.

You may qualify for lower costs on the Marketplace if you:

- Are uninsured and are not offered health insurance through your job
- Are a U.S. citizen or permanent resident
- Have a household income between \$11,490 \$45,960 as an individual or between \$23,550 \$94,200 as a family of four.

Health Plans on the Marketplace

- The plans available on the Marketplace are all offered by private health insurance companies.
- Every plan will cover check-ups, hospital care, and prescription drugs, as well as labs, maternity care, mental health care, pediatric care, rehabilitative services, and vision and dental care for children.

How to Enroll

- Open enrollment in Marketplace plans began on October 1, 2013 and closes on March 31, 2014. Enroll by December 23, 2013 to make sure your coverage starts on January 1.
