All RSD and OPSB to Reopen Tuesday, September 4

NEW ORLEANS – All Recovery School District (RSD) direct-run schools and Orleans Parish School Board (OPSB) schools will reopen tomorrow, September 4, following closures last week as a result of Hurricane Isaac. RSD schools in Baton Rouge, St. Helena, Pointe Coupee and Caddo will also reopen tomorrow.

Power has been restored at all direct-run school sites and both RSD and OPSB staffs have fully assessed the facilities to ensure the safety for students, faculty and staff.

Efforts to restore power at many of the charter schools in New Orleans continues. Families with students attending charter schools should contact the local school directly for a status update and information regarding the school's reopening date.

A determination regarding the academic calendar and the makeup of missed days will be addressed in future communications with parents and schools.

Both the OPSB and RSD administrative offices will reopen tomorrow as well. The RSD Central Office will reopen at its new location, 1615 Poydras St., Ste. 1400.
