

About 504HealthNet

504HealthNet is a network of health care providers in Jefferson, Orleans, Plaquemines, and St. Bernard Parishes. Our providers independently operate more than 50 service locations, ranging from primary care and behavioral health service sites to medical mobile units. All of the clinics listed here accept public and private health insurance, or payments can be made on an income and family-size-based sliding fee scale.

504HealthNet has been integral in integrating primary care and mental health, promoting team-based care in the medical home, and shifting the focus to the social determinants of health. However, rates of obesity, cardiovascular disease, diabetes, and asthma far exceed the national average, and many of our residents remain uninsured. The majority of uninsured patients report no regular source of care other than an emergency department. As such, 504HealthNet is dedicated to promoting primary care access for the un- and underinsured, advocating for health reform, and reducing reliance on hospital emergency departments.

Formed in 2008, 504HealthNet represents the majority of the safety net working collaboratively to better meet the primary care and behavioral health needs of low-income, uninsured, and underinsured residents.

Glossary of Terms

The Greater New Orleans Community Health Connection (GNOCHC) – Public health insurance similar to Medicaid that covers primary and mental health care for adults aged 19-64 with income under 100% of the federal poverty level at a set list of clinics. For a list of these clinics please see page 35

Medicare – Public health insurance for senior citizens aged 65 and older.

Medicaid – Public health insurance for low-income families based on income and family size. In Louisiana, Medicaid is called Bayou Health.


Pharmacy Assistance – Discounted programs for eligible patients to save money on medication.

Private Insurance –Health insurance purchased by an individual or an individual's employer. Examples of private insurance are Blue Cross Blue Shield of Louisiana, Humana and United Healthcare.

Self-Pay/Uninsured – A person who pays out of pocket for a doctor's visit because he/she does not have health insurance.

Sliding Fee Scale – The percentage taken off a person's bill based on income and family size.

About Health Insurance

This section contains information about programs, clinics and organizations that provide access to health care services for all residents including uninsured and low income residents at low or no out-of-pocket costs. Enrollment in the noted programs is available through the New Orleans area community clinics featured in this guide.

Private Insurance

Private health insurance is typically offered through employers or other organizations. Some employers offer only one type of health insurance plan, and others may let employees choose from more than one plan. Private insurance is also for sale on the Health Insurance Marketplace which helps uninsured and under-insured individuals and families compare and shop for affordable health insurance plans as part of the Affordable Care Act (ACA). Most people who use the Marketplace will qualify for tax credits, which lower the cost of monthly payments. These lower costs are only available to those who apply for coverage through Healthcare.gov or call (800) 318-2596

Uninsured

All of the clinics listed in this guide have a commitment to providing care to anyone in the Greater New Orleans area regardless of their ability to pay. These clinics accept uninsured patients and provide care based on a sliding fee scale. A sliding fee scale is based on a person's income, and family size.

What to bring:

- Proof of income (Copy of most recent W2, field tax forms, most recent pay stubs, unemployment award letter, Social Security/Disability letter, or food stamp award letter)
- Government issued photo ID if the current address is not on the ID, a utility bill may be provided
- Birth certificate or U.S. permanent residency card*

If you have lost documents:

- Birth certificates: If you were born in Louisiana, call (504) 219-4500 or visit Dhh.louisiana.gov
- If you were born in another state, contact the state's Office of Vital Records. For a fee, you can order copies of birth certificates online at Vitalcheck.com
- Driver's license or state ID: If you need to replace your state identification or driver's license call the Office of Motor Vehicles at (877) 368-5463 or visit Omv.dps.state.la.us

Medicare

Medicare is health care coverage for senior citizens, aged 65 and older. To learn more go to Cms.gov/home/Medicare.asp or call 1-800-Medicare, (800) 633-4227.

Health Tips!

How to make the most of a visit with your primary care provider:

- 1. Write down any questions you have and bring them with you.
- 2. Bring a list of your prescriptions, when you take them, and the dosage.
- 3. If it is a new doctor, bring with you complete notes about your medical history, including any past medical problems, surgeries, and allergies.
- 4. During the visit, make sure you understand your diagnosis and treatment options.
- 5. If you don't understand, ask the doctor to repeat it, or write things down for you.

About Health Insurance

Medicaid

Medicaid is health care assistance for individuals and families with low incomes. Louisiana's Medicaid program is called Bayou Health. Learn more at Bayouhealth.com or call 888.342.6207 toll-free to learn more about Medicaid and find out if you may qualify.

You may qualify for Medicaid if you:

- Are a low-income parent of children under age 19
- Are a child under age 19
- Are pregnant
- Are disabled according to the Social Security Administration's definition
- Get financial help from the Office of Family Support (OFS) through the Family Independence Temporary Assistance Program (FITAP)
- Have corrected vision no better than 20/200
- Have no insurance and need treatment for breast and/or cervical cancer
- Receive Supplemental Security Income (SSI) from the Social Security Administration (SSA)

GNOCHC

The Greater New Orleans Community Health Connection (GNOCHC) is a program run by Louisiana Department of Health and Hospitals to support primary and behavioral health care access after Hurricane Katrina for Orleans, St. Bernard, Plaquemines, and Jefferson Parishes. It covers different services than Medicaid at specific locations.

What GNOCHC covers (from a GNOCHC participating doctor):

- Primary Care
- Behavioral health care (mental health and substance abuse services)
- Immunizations and vaccinations
- Preventative care
- Care coordination
- Most lab work and X-rays

You may qualify for GNOCHC if you:

- Are a U.S. citizen or legal resident
- Are between the ages of 19 and 64
- Live in Jefferson, Orleans, Plaquemines or St. Bernard Parish
- Are not pregnant
- Are below 100% of the Federal Poverty Level which is \$11,670 for a single person.

You can apply for GNOCHC in three ways:
