The RESTORE Act

- April 2010 BP Oil Disaster begins
- July 2011 -RESTORE introduced
 - 80 percent Clean Water Act penalties to Gulf Coast restoration
- April 2012 Louisiana Coastal Master Plan passed
- July 2012 RESTORE signed by President Obama



The RESTORE Act

Clean Water Act Penalties \$4.5 billion - \$17.6 billion

80% Gulf Coast Restoration Trust Fund

20% Oil Spill Liability Trust Fund

35% States' Equal Share	30% Gulf Coast Ecosystem Restoration Council	30% States' Allocation Formula	5% Gulf Coast Research, Science & Technology



The RESTORE Act

- August 2013 "Initial Comprehensive Plan: Restore the Gulf Coast's Ecosystem and Economy" approved
 - Five goals
- September 2013 Treasury regulations released
- August 2014 Interim Final Rule and RESTORE Council project selection guide
- September 2014 BP found grossly negligent
- Next steps
 - Trial resumes 1/20/15
 - Council project list
 - Permitting

RESTORE Act

- 9/15/14 Treasury Rule public comment
- 9/30/14 Submit projects and programs to State of Louisiana for consideration
 - coastal@la.gov
- 11/17/14 (no earlier than) RESTORE Council deadline for project submittal
 - Restorethegulf.gov

State Coastal Master Plan

- 10/31/14 2017 Master Plan project submittals to CPRA
 - masterplan@la.gov
