**MINUTE ENTRY**

This matter came before the Commission on Friday, December 12, 2025 through the Commission's Motion to Dismiss Appellant's Appeal for Lack of Prosecution pursuant to Rule II, 4.13 (b). Our Rules provide for dismissal of an appeal when an appellant fails to appear for a scheduled hearing. The Appellant failed to appear at the time and location established for Appellant's appeal hearing.

On Tuesday, November 25, 2025, a hearing examiner appointed by the Commission presided over an appeal hearing related to the underlying appeal. Present at the hearing was counsel for the Appointing Authority, Mr. Max V. Hagan-Camp. The Appellant nor counsel for the appellant appeared or requested a continuance. Mr. Hagan-Camp informed the Hearing Examiner that he contacted Mr. Waters on his personal mobile phone and reminded him of the hearing. Mr. Hagan-Camp stated that Mr. Waters told him not to worry about it and to have a good day. The Appointing Authority's counsel moved to dismiss the appeal for failure to appear, pursuant to Civil Service Rule II, Section 4.13(b), which was accepted by the Hearing Examiner.

As a result of the foregoing, the Commission GRANTED the Motion to Dismiss Appellant's Appeal.


