ORDER

The Juvenile Justice Intervention Center (“JJIC”) moved for summary disposition of Ms. Booker’s appeal of her termination on the basis that she was a probationary employee with no right of appeal under Civil Service Rule II, Section 4.1. The Commission heard oral argument on this motion at its September 12, 2025, regular meeting. The Commission granted JJIC’s Motion for Summary Disposition.

JJIC hired Ms. Booker on August 20, 2024, as a Juvenile Detention Counselor I. JJIC terminated her employment on July 3, 2025. Civil Service Rule II, Section 4.1 grants a right of appeal to “[r]egular employees in the classified service.” A “regular employee” is “an employee who has been appointed to a position in the classified service in accordance with the Law and these Rules and who has completed the working test period.” Ms. Booker had a one-year probationary period under Rule VII, § 1.1, so she has no right of appeal. *Oliver v. Dep’t of Finance*, No. 2025-00338 (La. 5/29/25)

Ms. Booker’s appeal is DISMISSED.
