
AGREEMENT

NOW COME the parties herein, the Appellant, Michael Hughes, and the Appointing Authority, the New Orleans Police Department (NOPD), through undersigned counsel, who represent that an agreement has been reached resolving the above captioned matter, prior to and in lieu of proceeding with the Civil Service hearing set on September 30, 2021. On November 2, 2018 the NOPD issued notice to Officer Hughes that due to his inability to perform full duties expected of a police officer, he was removed from NOPD's service. Civil Service records indicate an effective date of separation on November 3, 2018. Pursuant to the terms of this Agreement, the NOPD has agreed to rescind the November 3, 2018 termination and allow Officer Hughes to voluntarily retire effective that same date. In response to the NOPD's offered terms of resolution as stated herein, Officer Hughes, through his counsel, agrees to withdraw his Civil Service appeal.

WHEREFORE, the parties agree to these terms, as confirmed by the signature of their respective counsel below, and request presentation of this Agreement at the next Commission meeting.
