ORDER


The Commission denied the Department of Safety & Permits' Motion for Summary Disposition in docket number 9685 at its March 14, 2025, regular meeting. Docket number 9685 concerned the Department of Safety & Permits' termination of Ms. Goff's employment on December 13, 2024. The Commission's denial of the motion was based on the sufficiency of the notice under *Oliver v. Dep't of Finance*, No. 2024-CA-0290 (La. App. 4 Cir. 1/16/25). The Department of Safety & Permits then issued a second notice of termination on March 19, 2025. Subsequent to this second notice of termination, the Louisiana Supreme Court reversed the Fourth Circuit Court of Appeal in *Oliver v. Dep't of Finance*, No. 2025-00338 (La. 5/29/25), reinstating the Commission's decision that probationary employees have no right to a disciplinary appeal, without regard to the sufficiency of the notice in the letter of termination.

Based on the Louisiana Supreme Court decision in *Oliver*, the Commission is dismissing Ms. Goff's appeal of her December 13, 2024, termination in docket number 9685, rendering this appeal of her March 19, 2025, termination moot.

Ms. Goff's appeal is DISMISSED pursuant to Civil Service Rule II, Sections 6.1(c) and 6.5.
