AGREEMENT

NOW COME the parties – Appellant, Schantalyn Jones, and the Appointing Authority, Juvenile Justice Intervention Center (the “JJIC”) through its undersigned counsel -- who represent that they have agreed to resolve the above-captioned matter prior to and in lieu of proceeding with the hearing scheduled for August 25, 2023, pursuant to Civil Service Rule II, Section 6.7.


Specifically, the JJIC has agreed to reduce the disciplinary action taken from a four-day suspension to a two-day suspension. As a result, the JJIC will reimburse to Ms. Jones the pay and any applicable emoluments for the suspended days served on June 15th and 16th, 2023. The JJIC further agrees to reimburse to Ms. Jones the pay and all emoluments for the eight hours documented as *Leave With Out Pay (LWOP)* on the timesheet for June 2, 2023. Finally, JJIC will change the charge from “insubordination,” to the following sentence, “While Ms. Jones provided information on a critical situation, she did not supplement that information during further inquiry in a timely manner,” and maintain this agreement in Ms. Jones’ personnel file.

In consideration of the agreements by the Appointing Authority, as detailed herein, the Appellant agrees to withdraw her appeal in the above-captioned matter.

WHEREFORE, the parties, Appellant, Schantalyn Jones, and the Appointing Authority, Juvenile Justice Intervention Center (JJIC) through its undersigned counsel, request that this Agreement reached prior to the scheduled Civil Service hearing be entered into the record and be

presented to the New Orleans Civil Service Commission for acknowledgment at its next scheduled meeting.


