**ORDER**



SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT


NOW COME the parties – Appellant Glen Bagert (“Appellant”), and the Appointing Authority New Orleans Fire Department (the “NOFD”), through their undersigned counsel – who represent that they have agreed to resolve the above-captioned matter prior to and in lieu of proceeding with the hearing scheduled for February 25, 2026, pursuant to Civil Service Rule II, Section 6.7.

Specifically, the parties have agreed to the following terms:

1. NOFD will rescind the January 2, 2026 termination of Appellant, and Appellant will resign effective January 2, 2026;
2. Upon the rescission of Appellant’s termination and his official resignation, NOFD will ensure that Appellant has the opportunity to elect for coverage under the Retiree Health Plan for health insurance, beginning in the month of March 2026.
3. Regarding any unused sick leave for which Appellant chooses to receive a cash payment pursuant to Civil Service Rule VIII, Sections 2.6 and 3.1, NOFD will pay Appellant terminal leave valued at 50% of Appellant’s rate of pay;
4. Appellant will be considered eligible for reemployment pursuant to Civil Service Rule VI, Section 4;
5. Appellant will withdraw his appeal in the above-captioned matter.

WHEREFORE, Appellant Glen Bagert and the Appointing Authority, through their undersigned counsel, request that this Agreement, reached prior to the scheduled Civil Service hearing, be entered into the record and be presented to the New Orleans Civil Service Commission for acknowledgment at its next scheduled meeting.
