AGREEMENT

NOW COME the parties – Appellant, Shannon Jones-Brewer, and the Appointing Authority, New Orleans Police Department (NOPD) – through undersigned counsel, who represent that they have agreed to resolve the above-captioned matter prior to and in lieu of proceeding with the hearing scheduled for March 7, 2024, pursuant to Civil Service Rule II, Section 6.7.

Specifically, NOPD has agreed to rescind the disciplinary action of an oral reprimand taken under PIB #2023-0058-R via letter dated December 20, 2023. Appellant's PIB history will be corrected to reflect the rescission of this disciplinary action, and the disciplinary letter issuing an Oral Reprimand will be removed from her personnel file.

In consideration, the Appellant agrees to withdraw her appeal in the above-captioned matter.

WHEREFORE, the parties, through their respective undersigned counsel, request that this Agreement, reached prior to the scheduled Civil Service hearing, be entered into the record and be presented to the New Orleans Civil Service Commission for acknowledgment at its next scheduled meeting.
