

AGREEMENT

NOW COME the parties herein, through undersigned counsel, who represent that an agreement has been reached resolving the above captioned Civil Service (CS) appeal, prior to and in lieu of proceeding with the CS hearing. The New Orleans Police Department ("NOPD") has agreed to allow Arnisha Ambrose to use two annual leave days instead of two suspension days under PIB 2020-0211. Officer Ambrose will be reimbursed the two days of suspension served the week of September 12, 2021, but her accrued annual leave will be reduced by two days.


In response, Appellant, Arnisha Ambrose, agrees to withdraw her appeal in this matter. The parties agree to the terms stated herein as confirmed by the signature of their counsel. The parties further request that this Agreement be presented to the Commission at its next scheduled meeting.
