ORDER

The Department of Safety & Permits moved for summary disposition of Ms. Goff's appeal pursuant to Civil Service Rule II, § 4.1, on the basis that Ms. Goff has no right of appeal as a probationary employee. The Commission heard oral argument on this motion at its regular meeting on March 14, 2025. Ms. Goff appeared *pro se*.

The Department of Safety & Permits rehired Ms. Goff on as a Management Development Analyst on December 8, 2024. Her probationary period in that position would have ended on December 8, 2025. On December 13, 2024, the Department of Safety & Permits informed Ms. Goff that she was terminated. Based on the Fourth Circuit Court of Appeal's recent decision in *Oliver v. Dep't of Finance*, No. 2024-CA-0290 (La. App. 4 Cir. 1/16/25), the Department of Safety & Permits failed to provide appropriate notice under Civil Service Rule VII, § 1.1 of the reason(s) Ms. Goff failed the working test period. Rule VII, § 1.1 provides that "[a]t any time during his working test period, after the first two months thereof, the appointing authority may remove an employee Upon the removal, the appointing authority shall forthwith report to the Director and to the employee removed his action and the reason therefore [sic]."

The Department of Safety & Permits' motion for summary disposition is DENIED.
