AGREEMENT

NOW COME the parties – Appellant Tanesha Santemore and New Orleans Police Department (NOPD) – through their undersigned counsel, who represent that an agreement has been reached to resolve the above-captioned Civil Service ("CS") appeal, in lieu of and prior to the CS hearing originally scheduled for February 6, 2024, pursuant to CS Rule II, Section 6.7.

Specifically, NOPD has agreed to withdraw the disciplinary action taken under PIB #2023-0238-R of a Letter of Reprimand for the violation of *Rule 3: Professional Conduct – Professionalism*. NOPD will correct Ms. Santemore's personnel file and Public Integrity Bureau history, as applicable, to reflect the withdrawn disciplinary action concerning *Rule 3 Professional Conduct -- Professionalism*.

In response to NOPD withdrawing the disciplinary action, the Appellant has agreed to withdraw her appeal in this matter.

WHEREFORE, the parties, through their respective undersigned counsel, request that this Agreement, reached prior to the scheduled Civil Service hearing, be entered into the record and be presented to the New Orleans Civil Service Commission for acknowledgment at its next scheduled meeting.
