ORDER

The Sewerage & Water Board moved for summary disposition on the basis that Ms. Urbeso has no right of appeal as a probationary employee. The Commission heard oral argument on this motion at its July 12, 2024, regular meeting.

Ms. Urbeso was a probationary employee, so she has no right of appeal under Civil Service Rule II, § 4.1. Her one-year probationary period began on November 20, 2023, and she was terminated on March 5, 2024. Civil Service Rule II, § 4.1 grants a right of appeal to "[r]egular employees in the classified service." A "regular employee" is "an employee who has been appointed to a position in the classified service in accordance with the Law and these Rules and who has completed the working test period." Ms. Urbeso had a one-year probationary period under Rule VII, § 1.1, so she has no right of appeal.


