1. If we can keep "Street" as the suffix, that would be best. There are formal definitions for when we use Street vs Way vs Drive vs Ave vs Blvd
2. A few other Roberts:
 - a. Robert E. Lee (retired)
 - b. West Robert E. Lee (retired)
 - c. Robert Street (current) (Uptown)
 - d. Robert C. Blakes, Sr. Drive (current) (Central City)
3. This change will cause a large separation between Piety Street in Bywater, and Piety Drive in Gentilly Woods & Pontchartrain Park. Could cause confusion with emergency services.

- Total number of lots affected by proposal;
- Total number of residential, commercial, and industrial uses affected by proposal;
- Proposed street name; and
- Reason for the change.

The GIS folks in ITI can help pull some of this information for you.

We also need a statement of cost for the replacement of street signs from the Department of Public Works.

Please let me know if you have any questions about the above. Once I receive this information and we have a meeting with Chris, I'll have a better idea of which PAC and CPC hearing it'll go to.
