

I am writing you in support of two street name requests. New Home Full Gospel Ministries and the Blake family are requesting that Carondelete from Felicity to Martin Luther King be changed to Robert C. Blakes, Sr. Drive. According to the applicants, the 19 affected lots include 9 residential lots and 2 commercial lots on the street as well. Bishop Blakes was an outstanding spiritual leader and activist in the city of New Orleans for nearly 50 years. Mrs. Lois Blakes can be contacted at 905-4139.

Additionally, the New Hope Baptist Church is requesting that the 10 blocks of LaSalle between Earhart and Simon Bolivar be changed to Rev. John Raphael Jr. Way. According to the applicants, there are 9 single family units, eight double family units, 15 multi-family units, 12 empty lots, 22 blighted houses and three vacant commercial building on the location.
