When light are not functioning properly, the safety of visitors is compromised. However, the Parks and Parkways budget does not include funds for bureplacement or general electrical maintenance. Electrical needs include well labeled electrical panels, switchgears, timers, photocells, main circuit switches, breakers, water fountain maintenance (for the synchronized, color-lit, floating powered, decorative water fountains), bridge maintenance, pole lights, the signature archways and functional lighting for pathways throughout. Additionally, we would like to upgrade to LED lighting where possible. The signature "Armstrong Park" archway at St. Ann Street and the sculpture lighting are currently experiencing outages due to a faulty controller. The subsurface paving lights at the French Opera House sculpture are also experiencing outages each time the lagoon floods. The National Park complex, Fire House, North Rampart entrance, Congo Square and Municipal Auditorium areas are in ne of floodlight, bulb, lamp, ballast and timer replacements. Additionally, a thirty foot long sidewalk needs to be re-poured and a drain installe in the area near the Archway.
