**ZONING DOCKET 008/16** – Request by ELDRIDGE P. STEPHENS for a Zoning Change from an HU-B1 Historic Urban Neighborhood Business District to a C-1 General Commercial District and a Conditional Use to permit the sale of alcoholic beverages in a retail store, on Square 1077, Lot C1, in the Third Municipal District, bounded by Desire, North Galvez, Piety and North Miro Streets. The municipal address is 3319 N GALVEZ STREET. (PD 7)

**ZONING DOCKET 009/16** – Request by CAJUN BROAD, LLC for a Conditional Use to permit a fast food restaurant with a drive-through facility in an HU-MU Neighborhood Mixed-Use District, on Square 363, Lots 16B or Pts. 15-16, 15 A, 14 or 14 Pt. 13, 13 and M, in the Second Municipal District, bounded by Bienville Avenue and North Broad, Iberville and North White Streets.
