ZONING DOCKET 038/17 – Request by City Council Motion M-17-86 for an amendment to Ordinance No. 10,591 MCS (Zoning Docket 093/84), as amended by Ordinance No. 11,589 MCS, which established a CBPCD Central Business Planned Community District, to permit a projecting sign, additional rooftop signage, appropriate signage for tenants in this multitenant building, and additional signage as proposed by the property owner, on the entirety of Square 369, in the First Municipal District, bounded by Canal Street, South Villere Street, LaSalle Street, and Cleveland Avenue. The municipal address is 1500 Canal Street. (PD 1A)

ZONING DOCKET 039/17 – Request by City Council Motion M-17-131 for a conditional use to permit retail sales of packaged alcoholic beverages in a gas station in a C-2 Auto-Oriented Commercial District, an SC Suburban Corridor Use Restriction Overlay District, and a CT Corridor Transformation Design Overlay District, and the rescission of Ordinance No. 12,672 MCS (Zoning Docket 047/88) on an undesignated square or Square 1, Parcel 1, Prosper Marigny and Cazelar Plantations, in the Fifth Municipal District, bounded by General De Gaulle Drive, Westpark Drive, Westbend Parkway, and Cypress Acres Drives. The municipal addresses are 3500-3510 General De Gaulle Drive. (PD 12)
