ZONING DOCKET 110/18 – Request by 1532 St. Philip, LLC for a zoning change from an HMR-1 Historic Marigny/Tremé/Bywater Residential District to HMC-1 Historic Marigny/Tremé/Bywater Commercial District, on Square 178, Lot 1 or 13, in the Second Municipal District, bounded by Saint Philip Street, North Robertson Street, North Villere Street, and Dumaine Street.
