ZONING DOCKET 023/19 – Request by Stronger Hope Baptist Church for a conditional use to permit a community center in an HU-RD2 Historic Urban Two-Family Residential District, on Square 451, Lots 16, 1A, 1B, 2, 13, 14, and 15, in the Fourth Municipal District, bounded by South Galvez Street, First Street, South Miro Street, and Second Street. The municipal addresses are 2403 South Galvez Street and 3520-3532 First Street. (PD 2)

ZONING DOCKET 024/19 – Request by Robo Development, LLC for conditional uses to permit a micro-brewery and bar over 5,000 square feet in floor area with retail sales of packaged alcoholic beverages and live entertainment (secondary use) in an HU-MU Historic Urban Neighborhood Mixed-Use District, a GC Greenway Corridor Design Overlay District, and an EC Enhancement Corridor Design Overlay District, on Square 360, Lots 5 and 6 or Lots 5, 6, 9, and 10, in the Second Municipal District, bounded by Lafitte Avenue, Toulouse Street, North Broad Street, and North White Street. ZONING DOCKET 025/19 – Request by Rice Capital Holdings I, LP for a conditional use to permit a warehouse in an HU-MU Historic Urban Neighborhood Mixed-Use District, on Square 156, Lots 102-A, 102-B, 1, 2, 3, 4, 1-A, in the First Municipal District, bounded by Camp Street, Clio Street, Calliope Street, Magazine Street, and Erato Street. The municipal addresses are 1118-1122 Gaiennie Street and 1134-1144 Camp Street. (PD 2)
