


Disparities Persist Despite Reform Efforts

Looking at jail detention in January 2025, Black people were detained in the jail at nearly <u>5 times</u> the rate of white people, per 100,000 New Orleans by race.



The institutions of slavery and mass incarceration are historically linked.





In January 2025, Black people who were released from jail spent 43 days longer in custody compared with all other races.
