Motion: Approve the request for retention with the provisos that 1) the vertical and horizontal conduit lines at the left and right sides must be painted to match the building wall color to reduce their visibility, 2) the overall quantity/visibility of the strap attachments must be reduced, and 3) the exterior conduit must be addressed in the future if replacement is requested, such as by removal (and replacement with typical exterior condenser units with interior ductwork) or re-routing at the building interior (for example, in the attic), so this condition does not become a permitted non-conformity.
