




St. Bernard Avenue at Henriette Delille Intersection Safety Improvements

1700 Henriette Delille Street/ 1100 Saint Bernard Avenue


This project is an intersection safety improvement project funded by City of New Orleans bonds. The scope of work includes pedestrian crossing islands, and streetscape improvements such as ADA-compliant curb ramps at intersections. Please see below for the project phases:






Timeline: This project is scheduled to begin in the 1st Quarter of 2024, the week of February 25th and construction will last approximately one week if weather permits. Pavement striping will follow when the construction of the pedestrian islands and curbing is complete.

In general, construction work hours will be Monday through Friday from about 7 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. During construction residents can expect to experience temporary construction inconveniences such as limited access to areas within the construction zones, limited lane closures and parking, movement of heavy equipment, safety signage, and construction sounds. No road closures are expected during this construction period but temporary disruptions to traffic and parking may occur. For your safety and the safety of construction workers, please remember to use caution when traveling through active construction sites.

The St. Bernard Avenue at Henriette Delille Street Intersection Safety Improvements project is being constructed by Hardrock Construction, LLC. Prior to construction residents and business owners will be notified and discuss anticipated construction impacts, sequencing and traffic impacts. What to Expect During Construction

Construction Impacts

- Elevated noise levels from excavation, concrete placement, etc.
- Temporary road closures: During construction, it's possible that work in front of your home will temporarily prevent parking in your driveway or possibly on your block.
- Traffic may be re-routed. Visit Roadwork.nola.gov to see where active construction projects are underway and avoid the areas if possible.
- U.S. Postal Service and trash/recycling services will continue throughout construction; however, depending on conditions in front of your residence you may be asked to take your garbage and recycling bins to the end of the block on collection days.

Parking laws will continue to be enforced throughout construction. Avoid citations by becoming familiar with the City's Parking 101 webpage on Nola.gov.

Please be mindful that construction impacts every person differently. While seeking an alternative to your regular route, you may encounter residents who are not used to traffic on their block. Be sure to follow the speed limit signage and be considerate of others when parking.

Efforts to Minimize Impacts

- Construction signage placed around the sites.
- Any temporary road closures or service interruptions will be communicated to the public ahead of schedule.
- The City will continue to inform / educate the community about projects in advance of and throughout construction.
