About the Data

This dashboard presents energy usage, greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions, and energy efficiency metrics for properties in New Orleans. Below are detailed explanations of each metric and key term used throughout the report:

Energy Use Metrics

- **kBtu (Thousand British Thermal Units):** A unit of energy used to measure total energy consumption. One kBtu represents the amount of energy needed to raise the temperature of one pound of water by one degree Fahrenheit. It is a standard unit used to compare energy consumption across different fuel types (e.g., electricity and natural gas).
- Electricity Use (kWh and kBtu):

kWh (Kilowatt-hour): A unit of electrical energy. It represents the consumption of one kilowatt of power for one hour. This is the primary way electricity usage is measured.

- **kBtu Conversion:** For standardization, electricity usage (kWh) is converted to kBtu using the conversion factor of 1 kWh = 3.412 kBtu.
- Natural Gas Use (kBtu): Natural gas consumption is measured directly in kBtu, making it easy to compare with other energy sources.

Benchmarking and Energy Efficiency

• Site EUI (Energy Use Intensity) (kBtu/sq.ft.): Measures the total energy used per square foot of building space. It's a common metric for comparing the energy efficiency of buildings of different sizes. National Median values are provided by ENERGY STAR Portfolio Manager <u>as described here.</u>"

ENERGY STAR Score

• **ENERGY STAR Score:** A 1-100 scale that rates the energy performance of a building compared to similar buildings nationwide. It's a measure of a building's energy efficiency. Higher scores indicate better performance:

• **Score 75 or above**: The building qualifies for ENERGY STAR certification, indicating it performs better than 75% of similar buildings.

Usage by Site

• **Score 50**: The building performs at the national median, meaning it's average in terms of energy efficiency.

Greenhouse Gas (GHG) Emissions Metrics

• Total GHG Emissions (Metric Tons CO₂e): The total greenhouse gases emitted from energy use, measured in metric tons of carbon dioxide equivalent (CO₂e). This metric aggregates various GHGs into a single value to represent their combined impact on climate change.
