## FINAL AGREEMENT

NOW COME the parties, through undersigned counsel, who represent that a final agreement was reached resolving Kristopher Dass v. Department of Fire, C.S. Nos. 9694. Pursuant to C.S. Rule II, Section 6.7, the parties herein have agreed to resolve these matters prior to and in lieu of proceeding with a Civil Service hearing. Specifically, the appointing authority has agreed to reduce the disciplinary action in this matter from a six-hour suspension to a letter of reprimand.

The appellant, Kristopher Dass, will be reimbursed all back pay and emoluments for the suspension time served. In consideration, Appellant agrees to sign a letter of reprimand that will be placed in his personnel file and withdraw his appeal of the suspension in C.S. Docket Number 9694.
