FINAL AGREEMENT


NOW COME the parties, through undersigned counsel, who represent that a final agreement was reached resolving *Kristopher Dass v. Department of Fire*, C.S. Nos. 9694. Pursuant to C.S. Rule II, Section 6.7, the parties herein have agreed to resolve these matters prior to and in lieu of proceeding with a Civil Service hearing. Specifically, the appointing authority has agreed to reduce the disciplinary action in this matter from a six-hour suspension to a letter of reprimand.

The appellant, Kristopher Dass, will be reimbursed all back pay and emoluments for the suspension time served. In consideration, Appellant agrees to sign a letter of reprimand that will be placed in his personnel file and withdraw his appeal of the suspension in C.S. Docket Number 9694.
