AGREEMENT

NOW COME the parties – Appellant, Emile Riley, and the Appointing Authority, Department of Public Works (“DPW”) through its undersigned counsel – who represent that they have agreed to resolve the above-captioned matter prior to and in lieu of proceeding with the hearing scheduled for January 14, 2026, pursuant to Civil Service Rule II, Section 6.7.

Specifically, DPW has agreed to withdraw the disciplinary action issued of a two-day suspension. DPW further agrees to reimburse Emile Riley the two days of suspension served and all emoluments associated with the two-day reimbursement. Finally, Emile Riley’s personnel file will be corrected to reflect the withdrawal of the disciplinary action.

In consideration of DPW’s terms of resolution as detailed herein, the Appellant agrees to withdraw his appeal in the above-captioned matter.
