The Parties' motion is hereby GRANTED.



New Orleans Police Department, CS 9566*, pursuant to Civil Service (CS) Rule II, Section 6.7, prior to and in lieu of proceeding with the CS appeal hearing scheduled for April 16, 2024.


The New Orleans Police Department (“NOPD”) will rescind the Letter of Reprimand that was issued to Bradley Tollefson (“Appellant”) on January 25, 2024. Instead, NOPD will informally counsel the Appellant regarding the car crash that occurred on March 4, 2024.

In response to NOPD’s offer of resolution, as stated herein, the Appellant, Bradley Tollefson, will withdraw his appeal, as confirmed by the signature of his counsel of record below.
