ORDER

The New Orleans Aviation Board (NOAB) moved for summary disposition of Chung’s disciplinary appeal on the basis that he has no right of appeal as a probationary employee. The Commission heard oral argument on this motion at its March 13, 2026, regular meeting.

NOAB hired Chung on May 25, 2025, and terminated his employment on November 14, 2025. Civil Service Rule II, Section 4.1 grants a right of appeal to “[r]egular employees in the classified service.” A “regular employee” is “an employee who has been appointed to a position in the classified service in accordance with the Law and these Rules and who has completed the working test period.”

Because Chung never achieved permanent status, he has no right of appeal under Civil Service Rule II, Section 4.1. NOAB’s motion for summary disposition is granted.
