

AGREEMENT

NOW COME the parties herein, through their undersigned counsel, who represent that an agreement has been reached resolving the above-captioned Civil Service (“CS”) appeal, in lieu of and prior to the CS hearing on January 26, 2023. The New Orleans Police Department (“NOPD”) has agreed to rescind the five-day suspension imposed under PIB 2021-0155-P, reimburse the five days of suspension served and associated emoluments of employment, including but not limited to reimbursement of holiday pay withheld due to the suspension, correct Lieutenant Cutno’s Public Integrity Bureau history to reflect that recission, and remove the discipline letter from Lt. Cutno’s personnel file. In response to NOPD’s rescinding the discipline, Appellant has agreed to withdraw his appeal in this matter.

WHEREFORE, the parties herein agree to the terms stated above as confirmed by the signature of counsel of record. The parties further request that this Agreement be presented to the Commission at its next scheduled meeting.
