



AGREEMENT

NOW COME the parties herein, through their undersigned counsel, who represent that an agreement has been reached resolving the above-captioned Civil Service ("CS") appeal, in lieu of and prior to the CS hearing on March 9, 2023. The New Orleans Police Department ("NOPD") has agreed to rescind the two (2) day suspension imposed under PIB 2022-0128-R, reimburse the two days of suspension served and associated emoluments of employment, correct Officer Nolan's Public Integrity Bureau (PIB) history to reflect the rescission of discipline, and remove the discipline letter from Officer Nolan's personnel file. In response to NOPD's terms of resolution as stated above, the Appellant, through counsel, has agreed to withdraw his appeal in this matter.

WHEREFORE, the parties agree to the terms of resolution stated herein as confirmed by the signature of their counsel below, and request that this Agreement be presented to the Commission at its next scheduled meeting.


