The New Orleans Police Department ("NOPD") has agreed to rescind the two (2) day suspension imposed under PIB 2022-0128-R, reimburse the two days of suspension served and associated emoluments of employment, correct Officer Nolan's Public Integrity Bureau (PIB) history to reflect the recission of discipline, and remove the discipline letter from Officer Nolan's personnel file. In response to NOPD's terms of resolution as stated above, the Appellant, through counsel, has agreed to withdraw his appeal in this matter.
