



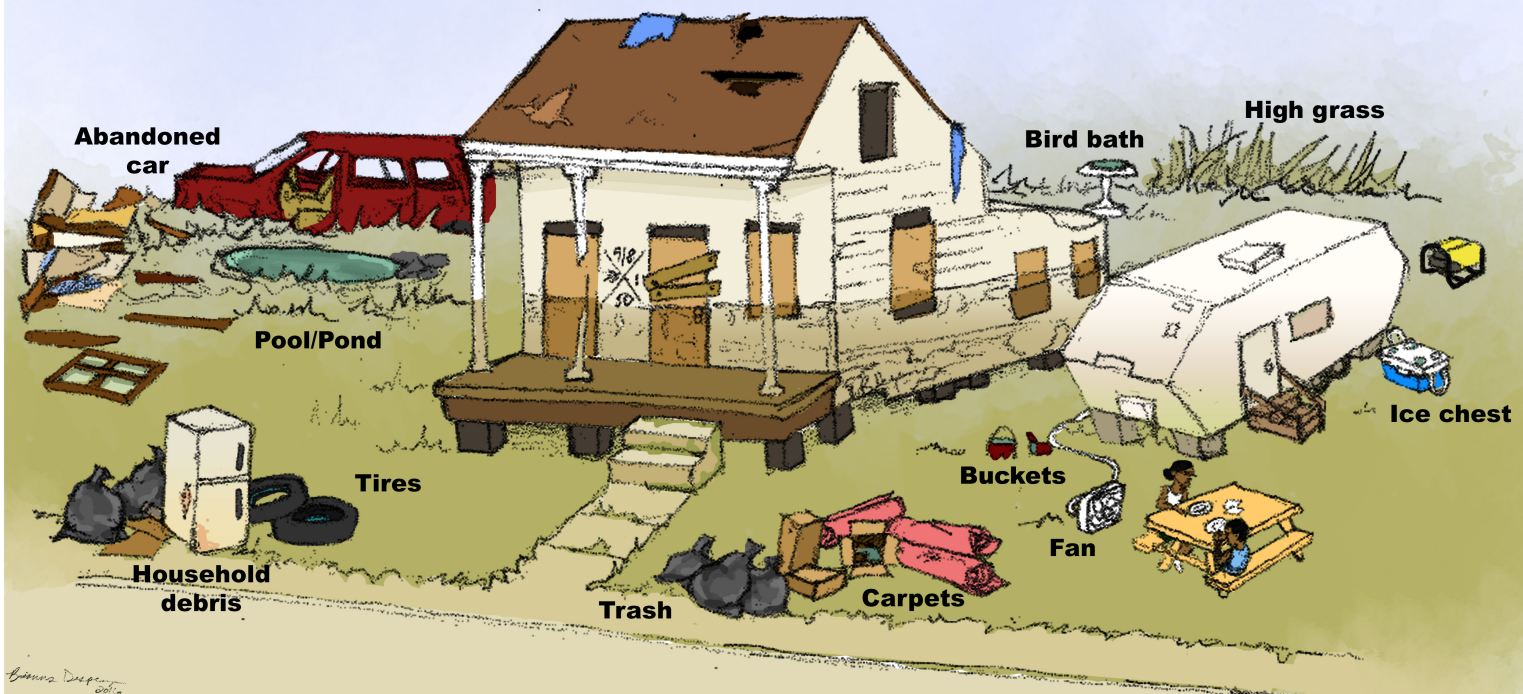

AVOID MOSQUITOES AFTER FLOODING!

Mosquitoes can be a nuisance after a flood but they can also spread disease. Take steps to eliminate standing water on your property and to avoid mosquito bites.



WHAT TO EXPECT

- Some mosquitoes can spread diseases such as West Nile virus and Eastern equine encephalitis (EEE)
- Floodwater mosquitoes usually appear 1-2 weeks after the event; most are pests and do not spread disease
- Mosquitoes can grow in containers full of standing water

HOW TO PROTECT YOURSELF



Limit activity at dusk & dawn



Apply Repellent



Sit in a air stream



Wear light weight clothing
