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## FINANCIAL FORECAST

## OBJECTIVE

To present the unaudited estimates for FY 2010 compared with the October revisions and a current outlook for FY 2011 revenue estimates based on revenue collections through April, 2011 for the City's General Fund.

## EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Revenue collections for FY 2010 were approximately $\$ 9.0$ million or $1.92 \%$ under the revised estimates presented at the October 14, 2010 Revenue Estimating Conference.

Based on current collection trends through April of this year, FY 2011 revenues are on target to achieve budget assuming no significant departure from national or local economic trends anticipated in the original forecast.

Non-farm employment in the US was projected to average 1.2\% for 2011. Actual growth for the first 5 months averaged a very anemic $.89 \%$ or at a rate consistent with $74.2 \%$ of expectations.

Job growth in New Orleans is performing better than the national average and is exceeding projections. Projections for payroll employment in the City for 2010 were 166,986 . Actual payroll employment for the first three quarters of 2010 averaged 170,100 or $1.9 \%$ above projections,

## FY 2010 UNAUDITED FINANCIALS

## TAXES

## PROPERTY TAX

The revised estimate for FY 2010 was $\$ 81.9$ million and $\$ 74.7$ million was actually collected for a variance of $\$ 7.2$ million. This uncharacteristic variance was the result of overly aggressive projection of prior year collections and the failure to account for the City's 2\% collection fee.

## SALES TAX

Sales tax for FY 2010 was revised to $\$ 144.6$ million in October, 2010 while actual collections amounted to $\$ 147.3$ million for a variance of $\$ 2.7$ million or $1.9 \%$.

## TOTAL TAXES

Over all total taxes were revised to $\$ 252.9$ million and $\$ 248.3$ was collected for a variance of $\$ 4.6$ million or $1.8 \%$ of estimate.

## LICENSES \& PERMITS

## FRANCHISE

Franchise fees were over estimated by $\$ 3.7$ million or $9.6 \%$. The principal cause of this over estimation was the result of a data recognition error resulting from the treatment and recording of FY 2009 audit adjustments. This data recognition error caused revenue projections to be over stated. This recording anomaly was not discovered until earlier this year.

## TOTAL LICENSES \& PERMITS

Total Licenses \& Permits deviated from budget by $\$ 2.6$ million or $4.4 \%$ which was more than accounted for by the franchise audit adjustment issue.

## TOTAL GENERAL FUND

The total general fund budget was revised to $\$ 468.1$ million in October and current unaudited collections for 2010 amount to $\$ 459.1$ million for a variance of $\$ 9$ million or $1.9 \%$ under budget.

## FY 2011 REVENUES

# REVENUE FORECAST 

## TAXES

## Property Tax

Property tax collections through April, 2011 amounted to $\$ 91.3$ million compared with $\$ 69.5$ million for the same period in 2010. Based on collections for the first 4 months, collections for 2011 are projected to be $\$ 99.2$ million, $\$ 2.9$ million or $2.8 \%$ variance from budget.

## Sales Tax

Sales taxes on retail sales for the first 4 months of the year were $\$ 44.7$ million compared with $\$ 41.3$ million for the same period last year. It is on pace to generate $\$ 135.3$ million for the year, $\$ 6.1$ million or $4.7 \%$ over budget.

Hotel-Motel tax collections for the first four months of 2011 were $\$ 4.0$ million an increase of \$400,000 over the $\$ 3.6$ million collected in 2010. Current trends suggest that collections for 2011 will be $\$ 1.2$ million or 11.3\% over budgetary expectations.

Automobile sales for this year amounted to $\$ 2.9$ million vs. $\$ 2.4$ million in 2010 trending $\$ 1.3$ million or $17.4 \%$ over budget.

## Total Taxes

The City collected $\$ 153.4$ million through April of this year compared to $\$ 126.8$ million in 2010. Collections for the year are trending $\$ 4.4$ million or $1.6 \%$ over budget.

## LICENSES AND PERMITS

## Occupational License

Collections through April of this year were $\$ 7.5$ million, $\$ 700,000$ over the $\$ 6.8$ million collected last year. However, no deviation from budget is projected. Procedural alterations initiated at the beginning of the year may have resulted in earlier collections as opposed to more collections.

## Franchise

As a result of an unseasonably mild winter, collections are running $\$ 800,000$ less than last year. With the additional technical correction for the 2010 preliminary projection, collections for 2011are currently trending $\$ 7.4$ million under budget. The outlook for franchise fees is further clouded by the recently enacted rate reductions.

## Total Licenses and Permits

Total licenses for the first four months were $\$ 24.2$ million, approximately $\$ 200,000$ over last year. However, the total will fall short of budgetary expectations by approximately $\$ 5.2$ million or $8.2 \%$.

## INTERGOVERNMENTAL REVENUES

Intergovernmental revenues are trending approximately \$644,000 or 7.0\% above budget.

## INTEREST INCOME

Prospects for interest income for 2011 have deteriorated even further than originally anticipated. The projected firming of interest rates has not materialized and prospects for their doing so over the remainder of the year remain bleak. Consequently, despite our doing better than last year for the first four months, collections for the year are trending less than half of budget.

## SERVICE CHARGES

## Health Fees

EMS collections are outperforming budget projections. Collections for the first four months are trending $\$ 2.3$ million, approximately $26 \%$ over budget on an annual basis. More effective and aggressive collection efforts implemented this year have significantly improved our recovery rates over last year.

## Sanitation Service Charge

Collections through April are trending $\$ 2.5$ million or $7.1 \%$ below budget for the year. The delay in the implementation of the new rates accounts for most of this variance. Additionally, the doubling of the rates has made property owners more mindful of the charge and quicker to respond to vacancies.

## Tax Collection

Total tax collection fees are on pace to exceed budget by $\$ 1.6$ million or $18 \%$. This trend is in no small measure a product of improved collection efforts implemented this year.

## FINES \& FORFEITURES

Revenues are trending $\$ 4.8$ million, approximately 13\% over budgetary expectations. Practically every revenue item is exceeding budget on an annual basis.

## MISCELLANEOUS REVENUES

As the title suggests, this revenue category consists of a myriad of numerous small items which do add up. For the first four months, collections are trending $\$ 1.8$ million or $6.2 \%$ under budget.

## GENERAL FUND OUTLOOK

General Fund revenues for the first four months are proceeding at a pace consistent with budgetary expectations. Despite the rather wide compensating variability within revenue categories, Total General Fund revenues are projected to remain on course. Projections at this early stage can be quite volatile and will change in succeeding months.

## ECONOMIC OUTLOOK

## NATIONAL ECONOMY

## BUSINESS CYCLE

The National Bureau of Economic Research, the recognized authority on business cycles in the U. S., has declared that the recession ended on June 2009.

Real Gross Domestic Product, the most comprehensive measure of economic performance, has grown for seven consecutive quarters. Growth for the first quarter of this year was 1.8\%, a rate of only $55 \%$ of the average long-term growth rate of $3.3 \%$. As can be seen in the table below, the current expansion is not as robust as previous cycles in the post 60's era, as measured by growth in real gross domestic product. The feebleness in the current growth rate is only exceeded by the past expansion for the first 23 months. However, despite this insipid rate of growth, it has remained positive even in the face of significant international political and economic turmoil. The weakness in the rate of growth has not affected its resiliency in times of domestic calamitous weather conditions and a persistently soft housing market.

Non-farm employment growth has been particularly anemic for an economy 23 months into an expansion. The lack of employment growth casts a worrying shadow raising doubt about its sustainability, an added measure of uncertainty which is never good for an economy at any stage in the cycle.

Although the employment weakness is not characteristic of post 60's expansion, it is not unprecedented. The last expansion was also slow in producing jobs, after 23 months, employment levels were 1.32\% less than at the trough compared with $1.13 \%$ today, as of May.

Contextually, it is important to keep in mind that the last expansion is not a very shabby precedent to follow. The last expansion beginning in November 2001 lasted 73 months and is the fourth longest expansion in U.S. history.

## LOCAL ECONOMY

## LOCAL OUTLOOK

Under the relentless and repressive weakness of the national expansion, the state, region and city economies are straining to stymie leakages in payroll employment.

By all measures, the local economy is performing better than the national economy. The local economy has been able to increase the number of jobs, a feat which was not replicated at the national level.

From the third quarter 2009 to the third quarter 2010, the most recent data available, approximately 2,000 jobs were added in the city and 100 jobs lost in the suburbs and the state. At the national level, non-farm employment fell by 119,000 jobs over the same period.

The local economy grew quarterly payroll at a rate that the national economy would envy. Growth in payroll for the period covering $3^{\text {rd }}$ quarter 2009 through $3^{\text {rd }}$ quarter 2010 was positive 37 basis points for New Orleans, negative 76 basis points for the state and negative 59 basis points for the nation as a whole.

The variability in the growth rates was less in the city than in the state or U.S., implying a more stable trend than exhibited at the state or national level.

This modest level of job creation, albeit a positive trend, is not sufficient to fully ameliorate the economic devastation visited upon the area by Katrina.

## NATIONAL ECONOMIC ASSUMPTIONS

Revenues, for the most part, are projected based on assumptions regarding the anticipated performance of the local economy. Projections of the local economy are predicated on projections of the national economy provided by the President's Council of Economic Advisers, the Congressional Budget Office and the UCLA Anderson Forecast.

The economic forecast incorporated in the October 14, 2010 projections, in retrospect, provided a sound basis for the revenue outlook for 2011.

## 2010

For 2010, most of the economic aggregates came within acceptable ranges of the projections with a few notable exceptions. The annual average unemployment rate was projected to be 9.7\% of the U.S. labor force but came in at 10.4\%, $7.4 \%$ over projection. Although the employment projections came in as expected, the labor force grew at a much faster rate than anticipated.

Other projected items which fared badly were the interest rate estimates, particularly, the short-term T-Bill rate. The rate was anticipated to accelerate for the remaining months averaging 32 basis points for the year from the 14 basis points which prevailed at the time. Instead, it flatlined and ended the year where it began at . $14 \%$, missed the target by over 56\%. The bell-weather 10-year notes fared marginally better but still missed the target by $11.5 \%$.

## $\underline{2011}$

The latest forecast for 2011 has not deviated significantly, as of the last March 2011 forecast, from that which was presented in October. The exceptions being inflation, which has increased, and the T-Bill and 10 Year Treasury Notes which have been ratcheted down significantly.
