Sample Elevation Plans



PURPOSE: Elevation plans provide the City Planning Commission with details regarding the current and proposed conditions of a structure(s) on a site. This sheet provides a simplified example of elevation drawings and some of the required details and measurements.

REQUIREMENTS:

Plans should include all relevant measurements and details related to improvements or modifications planned for the structure.

- Drawing of each side of all structures (principal and accessory), including architectural features such as canopies, shutters, and other ornamental features
- Indicate materials, colors, and textures proposed for structures
- Dimensions of all openings (e.g. windows, doors)
- Color elevations, if Design Advisory Committee review is required
