Sample Elevation Plans



PURPOSE: Elevation plans provide the City Planning Commission with details regarding the current and proposed conditions of a structure(s) on a site. This sheet provides a simplified example of elevation drawings and some of the required detail and measurements required.

REQUIREMENTS:

Plans should include all relevant measurements and details related to improvements or modifications planned for the structure. All sides of the structure should be included in elevation drawings submitted to the City Planning Commission.

- O Drawing of each side of all structures (principal and accessory), including architectural features such as canopies, shutters, and other ornamental features
- Indicate materials, colors, and textures proposed for structures
- O Dimensions of all openings (e.g. windows, doors)
- O Color elevations, if Design Advisory Committee review is required
