The public meeting will discuss recent increases in program funds: Communities Infrastructure Program - \$18,208,526.58 and Hometown Revitalization Program - \$15,072,327.27. The purpose of these funds is to create a safer and stronger Louisiana by leading the state's disaster recovery and long-term community resilience planning efforts with the great sense of urgency through innovation, partnerships, and best practices.

April 25, 2024 begins a thirty (30) day period of public review and comment and will end on May 25, 2024. At the end of the comment period, all comments will be reviewed, and a City response will be incorporated in a Response to Public Comment document.
