

## HEALTHY HOMES – CARBON MONOXIDE DETECTION ACKNOWLEDGEMENT

Pursuant to Sec. 26-656 (b) of the New Orleans City Code, when required by the Fire Code of the City of New Orleans or by La. R.S. 40:1581, each housing unit shall have an operable carbon monoxide detector with a long-life sealed battery.

This acknowledgement form is for property owners who have indicated that they do not have carbon monoxide detection systems within the residential dwelling units. This document shall serve as evidence that the status of all dwelling units, listed below, comply with the requirements of Sec. 26-656 (b).
