# 2015 Capital Budget Goals

- Over \$860 million in additional FEMA obligations since May 2010.
- Continue to expedite priority projects.
- Bond the Capital Improvement and Infrastructure Trust Fund to create \$10 Million in funding for Streetlights and other projects.
- Complete Closeout of FEMA Recovery Projects to ensure full reimbursement.

## Infrastructure Highlights


- DPW and Sewerage and Water Board are collaborating on all Recovery Road Projects.

- Stabilization of Municipal Auditorium and Roof Replacement








