**TERMINATION OF MAYORAL PROCLAMATION
OF STATE OF EMERGENCY (CYBERATTACK)**


WHEREAS, the Louisiana Homeland Security and Emergency Assistance and Disaster Act, La. R.S. 29:721, et seq., confers upon the Mayor of the City of New Orleans emergency powers to deal with emergencies and disasters, including those caused by fire, flood, earthquake, or other natural or manmade causes, in order to ensure that preparations of this City will be adequate to deal with such emergencies or disasters, and to preserve the natural resources of the City, lives, and property of the people of the City of New Orleans; *and*,

WHEREAS, on December 13, 2019, a “Mayoral Proclamation Declaration of State of Emergency” was filed with the Clerk of Court pursuant to the Louisiana Homeland Security and Emergency Assistance and Disaster Act, La. R.S. 29:721, et seq., as a state of emergency was declared to exist given the potential impacts of and ongoing emergency due to a breach of cybersecurity incident on or about 11:00 a.m. on December 13, 2019; *and*,

WHEREAS, said declaration is no longer necessary;

NOW THEREFORE, I, LATOYA CANTRELL, Mayor of the City of New Orleans, by virtue of the authority vested in me as the Mayor of the City of New Orleans by the Constitution and laws of the State of Louisiana and the Home Rule Charter and laws of the City of New Orleans, **HEREBY TERMINATE THE EMERGENCY PROCLAMATION DECLARED AND FILED ON DECEMBER 13, 2019.**
