Training Institute is a free program seeking to enable parents to become better leading advocates for children. This program helps parents develop the civic skills necessary to connect with government, analyze civic issues and bring about change.

The cornerstones of the program are respect, validation and a belief that when the tools of democracy are understood, the public will actively engage in civic life.

Parents are offered four (4) phases of training:

A retreat to develop the group and define the mission;

A 10-week course on parent leadership;

A 10-week study of politics, policy and media; and A community project to practice the learning within a community context.

How are the participants selected?

Parents will be selected for each class with consideration given to their ability to commit to attending the entire program as well as how their participation in the program will enhance diversity, strength and learning for the group as a whole.
