RE: Renewing/Transferring a CPNC with outstanding parking or traffic camera fines

Effective immediately, a CPNC cannot be renewed if the current vehicle associated with the CPNC has any outstanding parking or traffic camera fines unless;

- a) The fines have been paid in full;
- b) A payment plan has been set up with the Department of Public Works Parking Division to pay off the fines.
- c) The fines are in dispute.

If the payment plan falls into default, the CPNC cannot be renewed until the fines are paid in full.

Furthermore, a CPNC shall not be transferred if the current holder has any outstanding parking or traffic camera fines associated with the CPNC. All aforementioned fines must be paid prior to the transfer of the CPNC.
