Todd is expecting a cost increase in supplies (ex. stakes).

Angela experiencing freight charge vs delivery charge due to the size of trees. HCS utilizing water retention polymers due to mulch costs.<sup>1</sup>

c. Community Engagement

HCS, WWGS, and Groundwork engage neighborhoods for property-owner permission to plant on the ROW; however, they have experienced harassment and tree vandalism. Anna asked for any photographic examples of tree vandalism to utilize in any future PSAs. Jeff suggested greater awareness on who maintains a tree post planting (ex. residents will not grant permission if they believe they are responsible for the care of the tree in the future). PKW will clarify the Tree Planting Permit on who is responsible for the care of a tree post 1-year.<sup>2</sup> Anna to research funding opportunities for a citywide PSA. Dr. Chalk prioritized tv, radio, and social media vs print. Brittany to research translating Spanish and Vietnamese planting documents; Dr. Chalk added ACS has a Spanish interpreter on staff.

Anna to coordinate compilation of partner communication and outreach methods.
