Comments to First Substantial Amendment to
National Disaster Resilience Competition (NDRC) Action Plan

The City of New Orleans is the recipient of \$141,260,569.00 in Community Development Block Grant disaster recovery (CDBG-DR) from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) for the National Disaster Resilience Competition (NDRC) to assist in undertaking projects and programs that will enhance local communities recover from past disasters while improving their ability to withstand future extreme events.

As required by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development, the City of New Orleans, Office of Community Development, D-CDBG Programmatic Unit is preparing to submit a draft of the Substantial Amendment #1 to the National Disaster Resilience Competition (NDRC) Action Plan **for the use of federal funds.**

Substantial Action Plan Amendment #1 proposes reallocating \$13,825,055.19 of Community Development Block Grants- Disaster Recovery (CDBG-DR) funds between programs, deleting the NDR Milne Campus and replacing it with the NDR Milneburg Neighborhood Stormwater Resilience project, and to change the name of the Orleans and London Avenue Canals to Gentilly Canals and Lagoons.
